



## **Report of the AAFP Delegation**

The 2025 Congress of Delegates convened in Anaheim from October 4 -6. The reference committees again met in advance to discuss resolutions and make recommendations to the Congress.

New Jersey had five Resolutions presented to the Congress of Delegates:

### **Resolution 202 Inclusion of IUD Insertion Related Pain Management in Family**

**Medicine Residency Programs** This resolution was reaffirmed as current policy based on a very similar 2024 Resolution.

### **Resolution 204 Updating Educational Resources and Financial Models to Preserve**

**Family Medicine Access and Residency Training Programs** The reference committee received only support of the resolution. The concern was the complexity of the ask and the possible unintended consequences of the tool. The resolution was referred to the board.

### **Resolution 310 Ensuring Responsible Integration of Artificial Intelligence to Reduce**

**Burden in Primary Care** This resolution was adopted.

### **Resolution 311 Liability Insurance for Employed Physician**

There was some misunderstanding from the Reference Committee on the intent of this resolution and it was referred to the board. In the meantime, we reached out to the incoming Board Chair Jen Brull, MD with our concerns and an updated letter was sent to the board to clear possible misconceptions. The board will report back in a year.

### **Resolution 404 CDC Gaps in Data**

This resolution was referred to the board.

The new format of virtual reference committees ahead of the Congress with extracted resolutions debated in separate session again resulted in a more stream-lined and efficient process for discussing resolutions. Furthermore, the Nominations Committee again presented an increase in candidates for Board of Directors positions, in total, ten candidates for three positions.

The elections results for the 2025-2026 Board of Directors were as follows:

President-Elect: Kisha Davis, MD, MPH, FFAFP of Maryland



Speaker: Russell Kohl, MD, FAAFP of Kansas who also announced he is not running next year for Speaker

Vice Speaker: Daron Gersch, MD, FAAFP of Minnesota who announced as well that he will not be running next year for Vice Speaker

Directors: Tracy Hendershot, DC, MD, FAAFP of West Virginia, Robyn Liu, MD, MPH, FAAFP of Oregon, and Douglas Spotts, MD, FAAFP of Pennsylvania

This year, the AAFP Congress of Delegates will convene October 19-21, 2026 in Nashville, Tennessee, overlapping with FMX which will be from October 20-24, 2026.
